ADULT EDUCATION DURING LENT

During the remainder of Lent, Rev. Dr. Tucker will lead Adult Education on Sundays at 10:30 AM during Lent (March 10, 17, 24, 31, April 7th). We will read and discuss N.T. Wright's devotional: Lent For Everyone (Luke Year C)

The Rev. Dr. Martha Tucker will facilitate a discussion of these daily devotionals. All are welcome to these gatherings which will lead us more deeply into the season which, more than any other, forms us as Christians.

Also, on Wednesdays in Lent (March 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>) we will gather at 7:00 PM to consider the various types of prayer. We are called as Christians to pray without ceasing (Ephesians) but we often don't know how? There is no one formula and yet creating a deeper understanding of the forms of prayer and why they are used may help us develop our relationship with the Living God. Topics include: The Lord's Prayer, Eucharistic Prayer, Contemplative Prayer, Intercessory Prayer. All are welcome.

On March 31<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 PM there will be a special Family Service led by Rev. Dr. Tucker geared towards children, but everyone is encouraged to attend. For Further questions please contact the Parish Office at 860-364-5260.

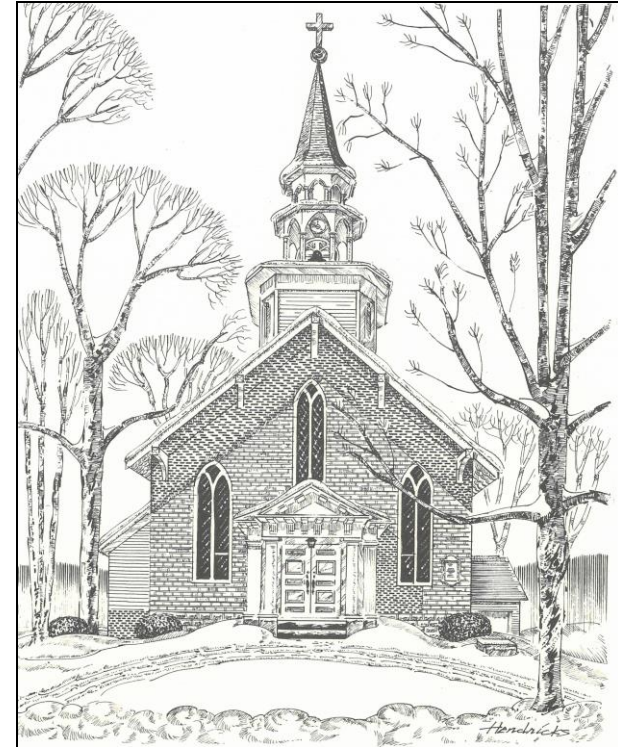
